

Carnaby HE2 Control v0.3.0 Beta release notes

The Carnaby HE2 Control plugin has been tested on the following

DAWs:

- Cubase 13
- Live 12
- Logic Pro 10
- FL Studio 21
- Live 12
- Reaper 6 & 7
- WaveLab 12
- Studio One 6 (some issues)
- Bitwig 5 (some issues)
- Sequoia Pro 17

Other DAWs may work but have not been tested and are not formally supported. Pro Tools AAX is forthcoming.

Operating Systems:

- Mac OS 13 & 14
- Windows 10 & 11

Other operating systems may be compatible but have not been tested and are not formally supported.

Known issues

Both Mac OS & Windows

- Reconnecting to the HE2 hardware device does not always update the parameter state from the plugin to the hardware, work around is to save and load preset
- Hardware-plugin handshake can hang and/or drop. If this happens, turn the hardware off and on again whilst the plugin is running.
- This installer will not delete the previous beta standalone application v0.1.6, please remove this yourself.
- Automating mode change (dual mono/stereo/mid side) sends all chan 2 values to DAW
- The “follow hardware” defaults to off
- AAX plugin is not currently supported, release forthcoming.
- Channel 2 settings are not currently stored when moving from dual mono to stereo mode

- Two mono plugin instances on separate DAW tracks controlling one hardware unit is not currently supported, release forthcoming
- No default state preset
- Multiple HE2 hardware in one DAW session is not currently supported. This will be fixed in a forthcoming release.
- Pressing the “Reload preset” button, if a preset has not already been loaded, removes the preset name from GUI
- A prompt stating “another application is using it” will sometimes display, even if nothing appears to be using it.
- The first preset in the list is displayed on plugin boot, but not will not automatically load
- When the stereo instance is launched it will default to dual mono instead of stereo

Mac OS Only

- Bitwig 5 VST3 plugin not opening
- Bitwig 5 Plugin crash
- Automating mode change sends all chan 2 to DAW
- In Logic Pro touch mode automation from hardware does not work
- The AU plugin in Studio One 6 is not recalling the parameters on Song recall, we suggest you use the VST3 instead.

Windows Only

- Using multiple plugins with “follow hardware” updates all connected plugins from hardware parameter changes.
- The connected hardware GUI menu sometimes reverts to “none” even if the connection remains.
- We have not signed the installer, work around is when “Windows protected your PC” pops up click “More info” then “Run anyway”
